Requirements for results to be considered

1. Each competition result can only be used to nominate one coach.
2. Results achieved by the same athlete in both senior and junior events will only be counted in either category.
3. Results of demonstration / exhibition events of competitions will not be counted.
4. Only results of athletes fulfilling the three-year residency criteria will be counted.
5. For team events, all members of the team must fulfill the 3-year residency requirement, and all should be eligible to represent Hong Kong to participate in Asian Games and/ or Olympic Games.
6. Only results in competitions sanctioned/recognised/endorsed by the relevant IF/AF will be considered, except for the National Games and National Championships.
7. Only results in events with the participation of four or more countries or regions, will be counted.
8. International open/professional events with six or more current world top 10 ranking players taking part will be considered at 4/5-point level.
9. For team sports, results in inter-club competitions, whether local or international, will not be counted.

Note:

- The above “Evaluation Criteria” is adapted from the HKSI’s “Evaluation Criteria for Elite Vote Generic Table”.
- The above “Evaluation Criteria” serve as a guideline. **NSAs should use the respective sports-specific Elite Vote Scoring Table to evaluate their achievements.**

- * For Olympic Games and Asian Games medal results, the minus-one rule will be applied, meaning that athletes must have beaten at least 1 opponent in the competition
